Vaccination Recommendations for Puppies

Puppies 6-8 weeks - PUPKIT – New Puppy/Kitten Exam

PUP1 - Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parainfluenza, Parvo (DA2PP)
ANNBORD or BORBOOST – Bordetella – lifestyle dependant
Deworming for hook and round worms
Start heartworm and flea control
Discuss behavior/training, microchipping, spay/neuter, tooth development/care, diet/BCS, toxic plants/household hazards, socialization/fear prevention, boosters, grooming, emergency procedure

Puppies 8-10 weeks - PUPKITP – Puppy/Kitten Progress Exam

PUP2 - Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parainfluenza, Parvo (DA2PP)
+/- Lepto (DA2PP4L) mainly dependant on age/size and lifestyle
ANNBORD or BORBOOST – Bordetella – if not already completed
Deworming for hook and round worms
Size appropriate heartworm/flea prevention sample
Discuss problems and any topics not previously covered

Puppies 11-13 weeks - PUPKITP – Puppy/Kitten Progress Exam

PUP3 - Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parainfluenza, Parvo (DA2PP)
+/- Lepto (DA2PP4L) mainly dependant on age/size and lifestyle
ANNBORD or BORBOOST – Bordetella – if not already completed
K9RAB – Rabies Vaccine can be given as early as 12 weeks but prefer to wait until older
Deworming for hook and round worms
Size appropriate heartworm/flea prevention sample
Discuss problems and any topics not previously covered

Puppies 14-16 weeks (or older) - PUPKITP – Puppy/Kitten Progress Exam

PUP4 - Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parainfluenza, Parvo (DA2PP)
+/- Lepto (DA2PP4L) mainly dependant on age/size and lifestyle
ANNBORD or BORBOOST – Bordetella – if not already completed
K9RAB – Rabies Vaccine can be given as early as 12 weeks
Deworming for hook and round worms
Size appropriate heartworm/flea prevention sample or supply
Discuss problems and any topics not previously covered
Schedule spay/neuter if desired

Intestinal Parasite Screen – IOPG should be submitted at least once during puppy series
Annual revaccination recommended for DA2PP4L and RV (can consider 3 yr rabies)
Semiannual or annual revaccination recommended for Bordetella based on lifestyle
Heartworm, intestinal parasite and flea prevention recommended every month
Spay/neuter recommended at 4-6 months depending on size and tooth development
Canine Influenza Vaccine (H3N8) and Asian Canine Influenza (H3N2) recommended only for those at risk

Vaccination Recommendations for Kittens

Kittens 6-9 weeks – PUPKIT – New Puppy/Kitten Exam

FCOMBO – Feline Leukemia/FIV/HWT can be run at 9+ weeks of age
KIT1 – Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Chlamydia, Panleukopenia (FVRCP)
Deworming for hook and round worms
Start heartworm and flea control
Discuss behavior/training, microchipping, spay/neuter, tooth development/care, diet/BCS, toxic plants/household hazards, socialization/fear prevention, boosters, grooming, nail care, emergency procedure

Kittens 10-13 weeks – PUPKITP – Puppy/Kitten Progress Exam

FCOMBO – Feline Leukemia/FIV/HWT can be run at 9+ weeks of age
KIT2 – Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Chlamydia, Panleukopenia (FVRCP)
FLEUK1 – Feline Leukemia Vaccination
Deworming for hook and round worms
Size appropriate heartworm/flea prevention sample or supply
Discuss problems and any topics not previously covered

Kittens 14-16 weeks – PUPKITP – Puppy Kitten Progress Exam

FCOMBO – Feline Leukemia/FIV/HWT can be run at 9+ weeks of age
KIT3 – Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Chlamydia, Panleukopenia (FVRCP)
Or
FVRCPRV – FVRCP + RV
FLEUK – Feline Leukemia Vaccination
Deworming for hook and round worms
Size appropriate heartworm/flea prevention supply
Discuss problems and any topics not previously covered
Schedule spay/neuter if desired

Intestinal Parasite Screen – IOPG should be submitted at least once during kitten series
Annual revaccination recommended for FVRCP and RV
Revaccination for Feline Leukemia is lifestyle dependant
Heartworm, intestinal parasite and flea prevention recommended every month
Spay/neuter recommended at 4-6 months depending on size
